Summary of Church Council (CC) Minutes of Meeting 17 February, 2021.

- In order for the singers to be Covid-safe, 10 foam microphone covers have been purchased, with each singer receiving one cover for their personal use.
- CC made its annual commitment to Safe Church:

"The Western Heights Uniting Church Council is committed to providing safe places where people are cared for, nurtured and sustained. We have today reaffirmed the Keeping Children Safe Statement of Commitment.

Through it, we recommit ourselves to the care, protection and safety of all people, particularly those who are vulnerable."

- An O.H.& S team is being formed to create protocols when someone is unwell at church.
- Church Groups that report to CC are asked to do so in the months of **March**, **May**, **July**, **September and November**, using the reporting pro-forma for the group.
- A huge thank-you to all who have in any way assisted in the refurbishment of the manse.
- Thank-you to Bruce Rookes for the work he has just completed in creating more office space for our tenants in the eastern buildings. A huge effort!!
- Rev. Narelle Collas and Rev. Craig Collas have been accepted into the membership of Western Heights. A warm Western Heights welcome to both!
- Sharn Waldron has been nominated and endorsed by CC as our representative on the PRC (Pastoral Relations Committee). Approval for this appointment will be sought from the congregation at the AGM. Sharn is currently a member of the PRC.
- "Geelong Pentecost" is supported by the CC. See separate notice in this newsletter.
- The PRC has approved the extension of supply of Rev. Bruce Waldron to 23 May, 2021.


