MARK 9:2-9

² Six days later, Jesus took with him Peter and James and John, and led them up a high mountain apart, by themselves. And he was transfigured before them, ³ and his clothes became dazzling white, such as no one on earth could bleach them. ⁴ And there appeared to them Elijah with Moses, who were talking with Jesus. 5 Then Peter said to Jesus, 'Rabbi, it is good for us to be here; let us make three dwellings, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah.' ⁶ He

did not know what to say, for they were terrified. ⁷ Then a cloud overshadowed them, and from the cloud there came a voice, 'This is my Son, the Beloved; listen to him!' ⁸ Suddenly when they looked around, they saw no one with them any more, but only Jesus. ⁹ As they were coming down the mountain, he ordered them to tell no one about what they had seen, until after the Son of Man had risen from the dead.

Western Heights Lent Studies

February 21st to March 28th

A SERIES OF STUDIES EXPLORING MARK'S GOSPEL FROM PALM SUNDAY TO EASTER

Mark's Gospel is the only one that takes us, day by day, through the events of Holy Week, from Palm Sunday to Easter Sunday morning.

This study helps us to understand what Mark's narrative means.

- Why did he do that particular week, day by day
- Why did he decided to include these specific recollections in the narrative
- What did the things he included mean at the time of Jesus' death and resurrection and at the time that Mark was writing his gospel, forty years later.

It is a tradition, nearly as old as the church, for Christians to put time aside during Lent, to focus with a different intensity on their faith as preparation for Easter.

My vision is that our church (all of us) will get involved in sharing this 5 session Lenten Study with each other during the five weeks of Lent.

- We might do it in existing groups
- We might get together with a bunch of people to do it.
- We might join up with some friends online.
- We might come down to the church and meet here for that purpose. Some times will be offered and if you'd like to arrange one, let me (Bruce) know.

I'd really love it if everyone got involved and then capped it off, using the Holy Week Services

Wednesday 7.30 We wash each other's hands rather than feet

Thursday 7.30 We travel together through that Last Supper

Friday 7.30 With the disciples, we go to Calvary.

Easter Sunday 10am. We all gather flowers from our gardens, as many as we can, bring them to church and blossom the cross, then carry it outside to sit in front of the church as a shout of 'Hallelujah! Christ is risen' (Yes there will be an Easter Egg hunt for the children)
