Mandatory Recording of Worker Vaccination Status

"Under current Victorian COVID-19
Health Directions, on and from
Friday October 15, 2021 an
employer must collect, record and
hold vaccination information if a
worker is, or may be, scheduled to
work outside the worker's ordinary
place of residence."

"An employer of a worker must not permit a worker who is unvaccinated to work for that employer outside the worker's ordinary place of residence. If an employer does not hold vaccination information about a worker, the employer must treat the worker as if the worker is unvaccinated. "

In our case at Western Heights, the employer is the Church Council who will need to collect, record and hold Covid-19 vaccination information for any member of the congregation, paid employee or volunteer, before we are to perform any form of work on the church premises (in other words, outside the worker's ordinary

place of residence). This includes all members of the Church Council, LAT, Covid-19 Task Group, Worship & Music Ministry Group, Safe Church Group, vestry stewards, stewards, greeters, Bible readers, morning tea volunteers, Messy Church volunteers, the persons who mow the grass, weed or water the church garden, deliver snail mail or flyers, record the service, and the Minister, etc.

What this means is that, before we perform any of these tasks at church, we must **show or e-mail** our Covid-19 Vaccination Certificate to Velma Oliver, so that she can record the information onto a "Mandatory Recording of Worker Vaccination Status" form. This will be done in the strictest confidentiality. Please contact Velma Oliver on 52415300 or by e-mail on lv.oliver@iinet.net.au if you have any concerns or questions. Thank you.

This Week's Eco Tip

from you church Eco-group. Have you noticed that tea usually comes in little pouches laden with plastic, wrapped in plastic, then cardboard, and is transported from countries around the world. We have our own tea, made and packed in Australia, and it comes simply in a cardboard box. If you like loose leaf, then Nerada is one of the cleaner, greener, low food-miles options, and it's a nice tea. And if you buy a simple tea infuser, you can avoid all that waste that comes with teabags. The other option is, put your loose-leaf tea in a strainer and very slowly pour the boiling water through it. You are left with only utterly organic waste and a very fresh cuppa.
