Mandatory Recording of Worker Vaccination Status

"Under current Victorian COVID-19 Health Directions, on and from Friday October 15, 2021 an employer must collect, record and hold vaccination information if a worker is, or may be, scheduled to work outside the worker's ordinary place of residence."

"An employer of a worker must not permit a worker who is unvaccinated to work for that employer outside the worker's ordinary place of residence. If an employer does not hold vaccination information about a worker, the employer must treat the worker as if the worker is unvaccinated. "

In our case at Western Heights, the employer is the Church Council who will need to collect, record and hold Covid-19 vaccination information for any member of the congregation, **paid employee or volunteer, before we are to perform any form of work on the church premises.** This includes all members of the Church Council, LAT, Covid-19 Task Group, Worship & Music Ministry Group, Safe Church Group, vestry stewards, stewards, check-in/sign-in stewards, greeters, Bible readers, communion preparers and servers, small-group leaders, morning tea volunteers, singers, musicians, sound-desk operators, cleaners, Messy Church volunteers, the persons who mow the grass, plant, weed or water the church garden, deliver snail-mail or flyers, record the service, worship leaders and the Minister, etc.

What this means is that, **before we perform any of these tasks at church**, we must **show or e-mail** our Covid-19 Vaccination Certificate to Velma Oliver (**at least a day before or immediately**), so that she can record the information onto a "Mandatory Recording of Worker Vaccination Status" form. This needs to be done once only. This will be done in the strictest confidence. All e-mailed copies are deleted as soon as the recording of the information has been completed.

The information that is needed is included in the "Covid-19 Digital Certificate" available on the **MyGov. App** and includes your name, the date of your second vaccine, the type of vaccine that you had e.g. Pfizer, AZ, Moderna, and the document number which starts with 1000. If you are not able to get your certificate online, you can call the **Australian Immunisation Register on 1800 653 809**, Mondays to Fridays between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.

Your vaccination provider can also print your immunisation history statement for you.
