Summary of Church Council Minutes 18th May 2022

- Devotions by Geoff Coots: Ephesians 5: v2 Prioritise time and attention to deepen relationships.
- Church Council received an update on the purchase of a defibrillator. Training has been conducted and it will be installed on the wall outside of the Horizons Room external door in an alarmed cabinet.
- The status and progress of actions in the WHUC Strategic Plan were reviewed. It was agreed that these be reviewed by Church Council every two months.
- Church Council discussed the Child-Safe Standard No. 1 that requires WHUC to establish a culturally safe environment in which the diverse and unique identities and experiences of Aboriginal children and young people are respected and valued.
- Temukisa led Church Council in a discussion on ethical questions about the use of our church properties.
- Potential mission proposals of a quilting expo later in 2022 and an art competition in 2023 are to be explored.
- A 'Mission Mate' contribution to support the Uniting Church in Armstrong Creek was approved.
