Summary of Church Council Minutes 15th June 2022


- Devotions by Peter Morgan: 1 Corinthians 13: 1-13. What can we learn from this reading about leadership?
- Church Council reflected on how it was operating and identified a couple of improvement opportunities to work on.
- The new defibrillator is to be registered with Ambulance Victoria.
- A donation of \$1,000 to the Kokoda Youth Program that supports life skills for 15-17 years olds was approved. The opportunity for one of the participants in this program to speak with us is to be explored.
- Church Council to consider a process for undertaking a review of Western Heights UC mission focus at a future meeting.
- The Keeping Children Safe Code of Conduct, September 2021, was adopted by Church Council.
- Church Council approved having only two stewards on duty at each Sunday morning worship.
- The next meeting of the Greater Geelong Uniting Churches Steering Group will be held at Western Heights in August. This Steering Group is exploring opportunities for collaboration between UC congregations in the Greater Geelong region.
